Second, in addition to the usual left-hand grade columns for "Vocabulary", "Reading", /Grammar", and "Listening", you will now find two right-hand columns.

The "SP" column should now be used to record the "Speaking" grade in ESL courses and for the "Speed" (i.e. words or strokes per minute) grade in skills courses such as keyboarding.

The new "Wr" right-hand column should be used to record to record each student's ESL course "Writing" grade.

As always, the "GR" right-hand column should be used to record each student's overall grade.
